Therefore, the applicants should have a sufficient command of Spanish or English to be able to follow classes without difficulty.</p> <p>Minimum requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Classes taught in English: <b>TOEFL 75 IBT, IELTS 6</b> or equivalent (except students from Canada, United Kingdom and United States).</li> <li>- Classes taught in Spanish: <b>B2 Certificate</b> or equivalent (except students from Latin America).</li> </ul>

<b>Requirements</b>	<p>Compulsory to contract health insurance that covers all the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Accidents</li> <li>- Medical, surgical, pharmaceutical hospitalization and ambulance expenses</li> <li>- Repatriation or medical transport in case of injury or illness</li> <li>- Repatriation or transport of the deceased</li> <li>- Civil liability</li> </ul>
