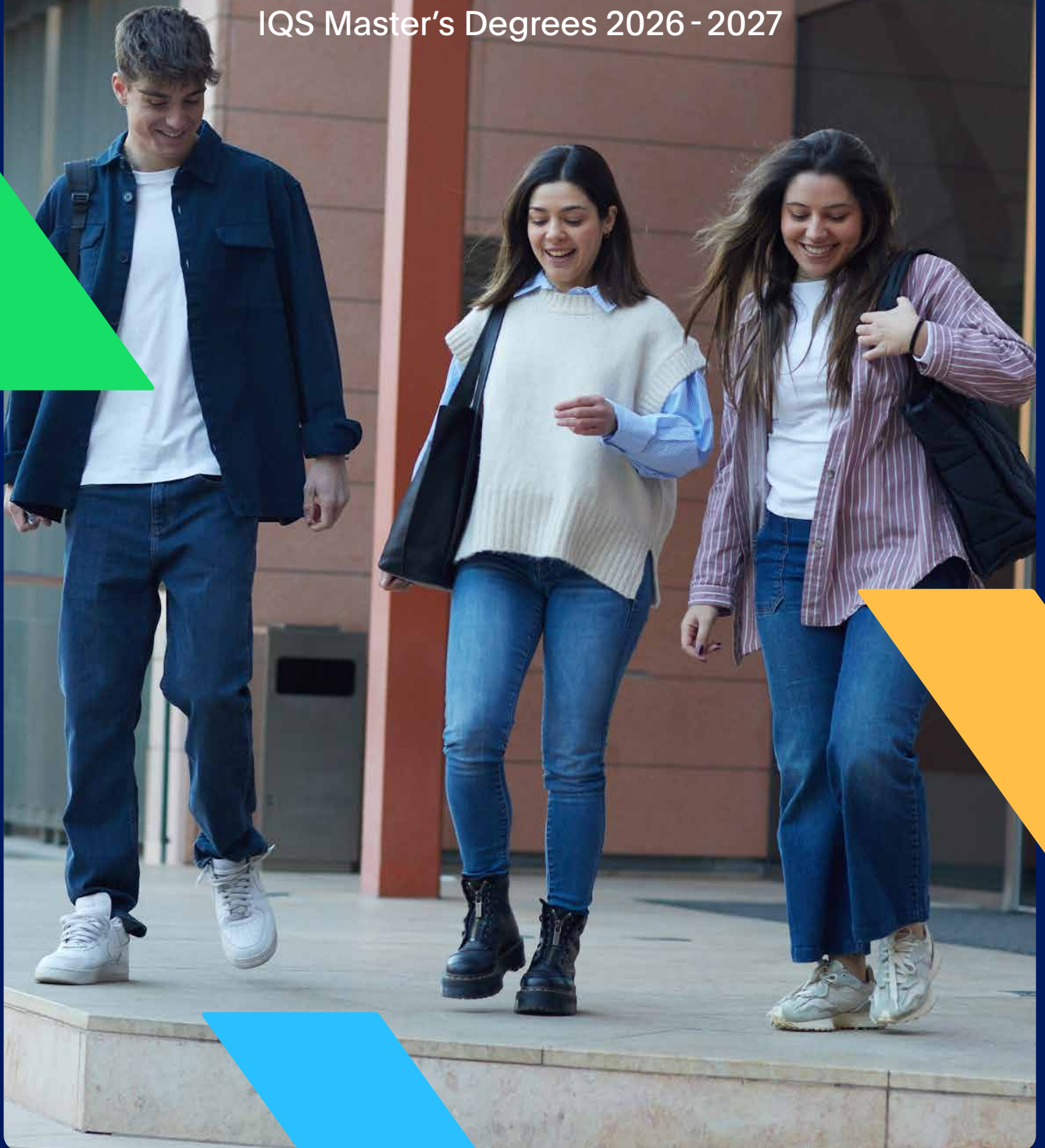




Scholarships, grants, and financing

IQS Master's Degrees 2026 - 2027



IQS Master's Degree Academic Excellence Scholarship

For students who are beginning their master's studies, **this scholarship covers up to 40% of the tuition**, for the best undergraduate academic transcripts, depending on the applicant's financial situation. These scholarships can be awarded to students enrolled in any IQS master's programme.

To be able to apply for a scholarship, the student must have already been accepted to study at IQS.

Terms and conditions to apply

Scholarship for up to 40% of tuition*

To apply for **Academic Excellence Scholarship**, you must fill out the required information on the following link, www.iqs.edu/en/scholarships, before the deadlines, when we request that the following documents be submitted:

- a. **Official academic transcript** with the grades obtained in your undergraduate degree. In the 1st and 2nd calls for submitting applications, academic transcripts for previous years and the 1st semester of the current year must be submitted. Students who have studied at foreign schools must access the following link: www.universidades.gob.es to calculate the corresponding equivalency and submit the certificate they obtain.
- b. **Letter of motivation** expressing the reasons why you are applying for the scholarship.
- c. European **Curriculum Vitae format**. You can find the template [here](#).
- d. **Cohabitation certificate** of the individuals living in the same household as the applicant, with a maximum date of six months.
- e. Document corresponding to the **electronic filing of the tax return** for the last financial year. In case of an individual tax return, a copy of the tax returns of both parents must be submitted. In case of separation or

divorce and, with guardianship and shared custody by the spouses, the income tax returns of both parents must be submitted.

- f. If you do not have to file your income tax return, you must provide:
 - a) Certificate that you do not have to file your income tax return.
 - b) Work history certificate.
 - c) Income and withholding statement of all members of the active family unit.
- g. **Employee documentation:** Copy of the last pay stub of the parents and relatives (siblings, partner, etc.) who work and live with the student.
- h. **Entrepreneur and self-employed individuals documentation:** Entrepreneurs or self-employed individuals must enclose a document accrediting the results of their work (corporate taxes or income tax on economic activities from the last year, the last four quarterly VAT statements, the annual VAT statement, etc.), and the investee companies.
- i. **Separation or divorce ruling and governing agreement**, if necessary.

*The 40% scholarship does not apply to Master Thesis credit hours for IQS School of Engineering master's degrees.

Master's Degree Financial Aid Scholarship

For students with financial need. These scholarships are based primarily on your family's income level and satisfactory academic performance. **Scholarships for up to 40% of tuition are awarded.**

To be able to apply for a scholarship, the student must have already been accepted to study at IQS.

Once the scholarship has been awarded, you have seven days to make the pre-enrolment fee payment. A student can only hold one scholarship at a time.

Terms and conditions to apply

Scholarship for up to 40% of tuition*

To apply for an IQS Master's Degree Financial Aid Scholarship, you must fill in the information requested at the following link, www.iqs.edu/en/scholarships, before the indicated deadlines, when we request that the following documents be submitted:

- a. **Official academic transcript** with the grades obtained in your undergraduate degree.
- b. **European Currículum Vitae** format. You can find the template [here](#).
- c. **Letter of intent** indicating the degree you wish to study or are studying, addressed to the President of the Scholarship Committee. The student must state the reasons justifying the scholarship application, the family's situation and personal circumstances, as well as any additional information deemed necessary.
- d. **Cohabitation certificate** of the individuals living in the same household as the applicant, with a maximum date of 6 months.
- e. Document corresponding to the **electronic filing of the tax return** for the last financial year. In case of an individual tax return, a copy of the tax returns of both parents must be submitted. In case of separation or divorce and, with guardianship and shared custody by the spouses, the income tax returns of both parents must be submitted.
- f. If you do not have to file your income tax return, you must provide:
 - a) Certificate that you do not have to file your income tax return.
 - b) Work history certificate.
 - c) Income and withholding statement of all members of the active family unit.
- g. **Salaried employee documentation:** Copy of the last pay stub of the parents and relatives (siblings, partner, etc.) who work and live with the student.
- h. **Entrepreneur and self-employed individuals documentation:** Entrepreneurs or self-employed individuals must enclose a document accrediting the results of their activities (corporate taxes or income tax on economic activities from the last year, the last four quarterly VAT statements, the annual VAT statement, etc.), and the investee companies.
- i. **Separation or divorce ruling and governing agreement**, if necessary.
- j. **Benefits:** Certification of household income from unemployment and pensions (widowhood, disability, orphan, etc.) or proof of not receiving these benefits, if applicable. A copy of the time period of unemployment or any other benefits must also be submitted, if applicable.

The guiding criteria for the assessment of the IQS Master's Degree Financial Aid Scholarship are:

- a. Having completed the pre-registration process for an IQS master's degree.
- b. The sum of the amounts of the tax bases of the income of the reporting members, divided by the number of members of the household, must be less than €20,000 per member of the household.

Master's Degree International Student Scholarship

For students who can prove they reside outside of Spain, have financial need, a solid academic record, and have been admitted to an IQS master's programme.

To be able to apply for a scholarship, the student must have already been accepted to study at IQS.

Deadlines for sending documentation

All applications for international student scholarships from November until March will be assessed individually. For subsequent dates, the following deadlines will apply.

- Letter of motivation** expressing the reasons why you are applying for the scholarship. The student must state the reasons justifying the application for the scholarship, the family's situation, personal circumstances, as well as any additional information deemed necessary.

Special IQS full-tuition scholarships for academic year 2026-2027 for international students

IQS will award two scholarships that cover full tuition for: one student from the **Universidad UCA in El Salvador** and one student from the **Universidad Rafael Landívar in Guatemala**, respectively.

Special grants for academic year 2026-2027

Grant for 30% of first year tuition fees

For academic year 2026-2027, special grants have been allocated for all students who enrol in the Master in Circular Economy and the Master's Degree in Analytical Chemistry. The grants will be applied automatically.

Master's Degree Sustainability Scholarship:

A grant for 30% of tuition fees will be awarded to all applicants to the Master in Circular Economy.

American Chemical Society Master's Degree Scholarship:

To commemorate its 150th anniversary, a scholarship for 30% of tuition is being awarded to all applicants to the Master's Degree in Analytical Chemistry.
